Admission requirements for applicants from abroad

- min. GRE-Q score 685
- min. TOEFL-IBT score 80 (valid for 2 years until the end of application period)
- a min. undergraduate GPA of 2.75/4.00 and a min. graduate GPA of 3.00/4.00 (from a graduate level program with thesis requirement)
- successful graduation from one of the undergraduate and graduate programs (with thesis requirement) stated below:
 - Mechatronic Systems Engineering, Mechatronic Engineering, Control and Automation Engineering, Control and Computer Engineering
 - Electrical Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Electrical-Electronics Engineering, Electronics Engineering, Electronics and Communications Engineering
 - Computer Engineering, Computer and Informatics Engineering, Computer and Software Engineering, Information Systems Engineering
 - Industrial Engineering
 - Mechanical Engineering, Mechanical and Manufacturing Engineering, Mechanical and Production Engineering, Mechanical and Materials Engineering, Materials

- 2 reference letters (at least one of the reference letters must be from the instructor whose lecture the candidate has attended in bachelor level)
- Letter of intent (in English)
- "Recognition of study" by YÖK (Council of Higher Education in Turkey)
- Candidates must apply for the recognition of their previous studies abroad by YÖK before further application to a graduate study in Turkey. The application form is available at

The form must be filled and send to YÖK Recognition and Equivalency Services Department after the payment of service fee (150 TL)

Applications from abroad will be evaluated based on graduate GPA (50 %) and interview grade (50 %). A min. of overall score of 70 / 100 must be attained in order to qualify for acceptance.

Applications must be made online in the application period. Incomplete or late applications will not be evaluated.
