FARAZİ DAVA YARIŞMALARI TAKIM SEÇMELERİ HAKKINDA

Türk-Alman Üniversitesi Hukuk Fakültesi, öğrencilerinin uluslararası hukuk pratiğine ilişkin bilgi ve becerilerini geliştirmelerine katkı sunmak amacıyla farazi dava (moot court) yarışmalarına katılacak takımlar oluşturmayı hedeflemektedir. Bu kapsamda hazırlanacak takımlar, özellikle uluslararası düzeyde düzenlenen yarışmalar özelinde eğitilecektir.

Seçme sürecine başvurmak isteyen öğrencilerimizin, aşağıda yer alan iki soruya ilişkin, İngilizce dilinde ve her biri dipnotlar ve başlıklar dışında en fazla 250 kelime olacak şekilde hazırlayacakları örnek cevaplarını 21 Ağustos Cuma günü saat 23.59'a kadar mootcourt@tau.edu.tr adresine e-posta yoluyla göndermeleri gerekmektedir. Süresi içinde ulaşmayan başvurular değerlendirmeye alınmayacaktır. E-Posta ekinde öğrencilerimizin mevcut özgeçmişlerini de cevapları ile birlikte göndermeleri beklenmektedir. Aşağıdaki sorulardan en az birinin cevaplanması yeterlidir. Yazılı cevap sunmayan öğrencilerimiz bakımından seçmelere devam edilmeyecektir. Cevapların PDF ve Word formatında iletilmesi gerekmektedir.

Yazılı başvuruların değerlendirilmesinin ardından, adaylarla ayrıca çevrimiçi (online) bir sözlü görüşme gerçekleştirilecektir. Görüşme tarihi daha sonra ilan edilecek olup, ilgili görüşmeye ilişkin tarih ve saat bilgilendirmeleri başvuru yapılan mail adreslerine dönüş yoluyla bildirilecektir.

REGARDING TEAM SELECTIONS FOR MOOT COURT COMPETITIONS

The Faculty of Law of Turkish-German University aims to form teams that will participate in moot court competitions in order to contribute to the development of its students' knowledge and skills regarding international legal practice. In this context, the teams to be formed will be trained particularly for competitions organized at the international level.

Students wishing to apply for the selection process are required to send their applications, by email to mootcourt@tau.edu.tr. For the application sample answers to the two questions below, prepared in English and limited to a maximum of 250 words each, excluding footnotes and headings, by 11:59 p.m. on Friday, 21 August. Applications not received within the prescribed period will not be taken into consideration. Our students are also expected to submit their current CVs together with their answers as attachments to the email. It is sufficient to answer at least one of the questions below. Students who do not submit a written answer will not proceed further in the selection process. The answers must be submitted in both PDF and Word formats.

Following the evaluation of the written applications, an online oral interview will also be conducted with the candidates. The date of the interview will be announced at a later time, and information regarding the date and time of the relevant interview will be communicated by reply to the email addresses used for the application.

TEAMAUSWAHLVERFAHREN FÜR MOOT-COURT-WETTBEWERBE

Die Fakultät für Rechtswissenschaft der Türkisch-Deutschen Universität beabsichtigt, Teams zu bilden, die an Moot-Court-Wettbewerben teilnehmen, um zur Entwicklung der Kenntnisse und Fähigkeiten ihrer Studierenden im Bereich der internationalen Rechtspraxis beizutragen. In diesem Rahmen werden die zu bildenden Teams insbesondere im Hinblick auf Wettbewerbe geschult, die auf internationaler Ebene veranstaltet werden.

Studierende, die sich für das Auswahlverfahren bewerben möchten, müssen ihre auf Englisch verfassten Musterantworten zu den beiden nachstehenden Fragen, die jeweils – Fußnoten und Überschriften ausgenommen – höchstens 250 Wörter umfassen dürfen, bis Freitag, den 21. August, um 23:59 Uhr per E-Mail an mootcourt@tau.edu.tr senden. Bewerbungen, die nicht fristgerecht eingehen, werden nicht berücksichtigt. Es wird außerdem erwartet, dass unsere Studierenden ihren aktuellen Lebenslauf zusammen mit ihren Antworten als Anhang der E-Mail übermitteln. Es ist ausreichend, mindestens eine der nachstehenden Fragen zu beantworten. Für Studierende, die keine schriftliche Antwort einreichen, wird das Auswahlverfahren nicht fortgesetzt. Die Antworten müssen im PDF- und Word-Format übermittelt werden.

Nach der Bewertung der schriftlichen Bewerbungen wird mit den Bewerberinnen und Bewerbern zusätzlich ein mündliches Online-Gespräch durchgeführt. Der Termin des Gesprächs wird zu einem späteren Zeitpunkt bekannt gegeben; die Informationen zu Datum und Uhrzeit des betreffenden Gesprächs werden durch eine Antwort an die für die Bewerbung verwendeten E-Mail-Adressen mitgeteilt.
