1	By understanding the functions of narrative forms in writing, he/she plans and creates a composition.		
2	He/she understands the purposes of using punctuation marks and uses them correctly.		
3	He/she understands the spelling rules of the Turkish written language and becomes conscious of using these rules in his/her daily life.		
4	He/she explains the characteristics of opinion writings. He/she gains an idea about how thoughts are developed in these writings.		
5	He/she distinguishes the types of opinion writings. He/she learns about these types. He/she examines sample texts from Turkish Literature.		

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6	He/she realizes the characteristics of artistic writings. He/she distinguishes this type of writing from opinion writings. He/she recognizes examples of artistic writings from Turkish Literature.
7	He/she distinguishes the types of poetry. He/she examines examples of different types of poetry.
8	He/she analyzes the elements of the story. He/she distinguishes the types of story.
9	He/she examines how the novel genre has developed in World Literature and Turkish Literature. He/she evaluates the differences of novel genres.
10	He/she learns about theater genres. He/she evaluates the differences by examining parts from examples of theater genres in World Literature and Turkish Literature.
11	He/she learns about how scientific research should be done. Examines how to cite sources in a scientific study with examples. Understands that citing sources is a scientific ethical rule when writing a scientific article.
12	Analyzes correspondence types. Understands the characteristics of these types.
13	Examines effective reading methods. Determines which methods to use in line with his/her own learning strategy. Becomes able to apply these reading methods in his/her daily life. Develops his/her own unique reading strategy.
14	Analyzes listening types and synthesizes which listening methods to use in his/her daily communication with people.
15	Comprehends the basic principles of an effective speech. Thinks about how this type of speech should be done. Evaluates the effect of body language on speech. Analyzes speech types.
16	Explains the pronunciation rules to be considered while speaking in an effective presentation. Understands how speech will make the presentation more effective by paying attention to pronunciation features such as stress, intonation, and articulation.
