Objectives	The lecture teaches the basics of the special law of obligations and the law of property. The first part of the course deals with individual contractual obligations, which are an elementary part of the civil law relations between natural and legal persons and have a significant influence on our daily legal relationships. The second part of the course deals with contractual obligations, which are not established by contract, but by law. The last part of the lecture is about the basic structures of property law, in particular the ownership of movables and immovables. The course combines a classical lecture approach with exercise elements through discussion of exemplary cases, which at the same time improves the competence for case studies in examinations.					
Content	Selected contract types such as the purchase, service and lease agreement, legal obligations such as the law of torts, the law of unjust enrichment and the agency without specific authorization as well as basic features of property law are dealt with.
