<b>Content</b>	<p>To inform students about the political, economic, social and cultural phenomena of the historical period starting from the classical age of the Ottoman state and ending with the death of Atatürk in 1938, and the background of these phenomena extending to the Ottoman state.</p> <p>To enable students to look at historical events in a versatile way.</p> <p>It is to introduce students to the basic theoretical concepts, discussions and methods of thought of different social sciences, especially history, around an interdisciplinary approach.</p>
