Google Classroom



Google Classroom, one of the educational workspaces offered by Google, represents a virtual classroom environment where online educational activities are organized and carried out.

There are three different ways to participate in any virtual class.




Google Classroom

You can attend online classes via Google Meet via Classroom, and view and follow assignments or tasks assigned by the course instructor.

It is also possible to see announcements and reminders about the course via the Google Classroom interface.

In addition, uploading assignments, checking the similarity of studies, receiving feedback, polling, in-class and out-of-class group work, discussion environments, exams and grading are carried out with different digital tools brought together in the Classroom interface.





Basic Classroom Features

It is possible to say that there are some basic activities and features when using Google Classroom in classroom learning-teaching processes.

Click to see how to send an e-mail to your instructors or classmates. Click to see how you can follow class activities.


Google Meet



Google Meet offers an audio and video interaction environment where multiple users can participate through different devices in online education processes.

It is possible to take part in a real-time, collaborative and safe classroom environment with Google Meet, which allows "taking learning beyond the classroom walls"

There are different ways to join a Google Meet video conference. It is possible to list them as follows.

Google Docs, one of the educational tools offered within the scope of Google Workspace, is used for activities such as creating, editing and sharing online documents.
